Once a resume is received, applicants will be contacted on a first come, first serve basis depending on qualifications. Applicants must:

- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Be certified in the State of Illinois as a part-time or full-time law enforcement officer
- Be of sound moral character
- Be able to pass a thorough background investigation
- Be able to pass a physical and drug screen
- Have no prior felony arrests or convictions
- Be able to complete a field training program
- Be able to work, at a MINIMUM, two nights per month, with a preference given to those with regular availability on the weekend (Friday, Saturday, Sunday)

Starting pay for certified law enforcement officers is \$16.00 per hour with an increase to \$16.50 per hour after completion of probationary period. The Mackinaw Police Department covers a village of 1900 citizens in southeast Tazewell County, and is staffed by part-time police officers with varying degrees of experience.
